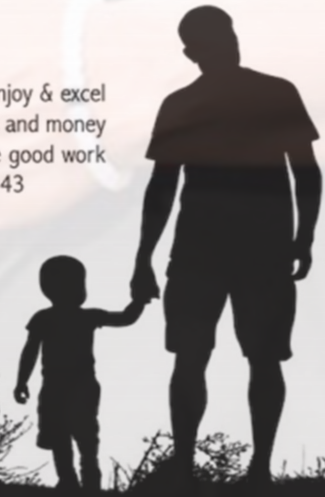
T IS FOR TESTIMONY
