She was licensed to preach the Gospel at Ebenezer Baptist Church in Hampton, Virginia, under the leadership of the late Rev. Dr. Walter R. Dean, a spiritual father who helped shape her early ministerial foundation.

She currently serves faithfully as an Associate Minister at Little Grove Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. Ralph Richardson III, Senior Pastor, where she continues to teach, preach, and support the work of ministry with excellence and humility.

Her ministry journey also includes serving as First Lady of Morning Glory Baptist Church in Gloucester, Virginia, where she poured into the congregation with grace, compassion, and steadfast dedication.

She is joyfully married to Rev. Dr. Darrell A. Hudson, and together they are blessed with four adult children. They currently reside in Suffolk, Virginia, continuing to serve God and His people with purpose and passion.

One of her favorite Scriptures is John 13:34-35 (NLT): *"So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other. Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples."*

BIOGRAPHY OF GUEST SPEAKER: DR. C. DIANE MOSBY

Rev. Dr. C. Diane Mosby is the visionary founder and Pastor Emerita of Anointed New Life Baptist Church in Henrico, Virginia. A passionate preacher, teacher, mentor, and servant leader, she has devoted her life to helping people grow deeper in their faith, discover their purpose, and serve others with compassion and courage.

Known for her warm spirit, powerful preaching, and authentic leadership, Dr. Mosby believes ministry is about meeting people where they are and walking alongside them with love, wisdom, and grace. Her heart for God's people continues to inspire lives across generations and communities.

She earned her Doctor of Ministry degree in 2012 and received her Master of Divinity from the Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology at Virginia Union University, graduating *summa cum laude* and valedictorian of the Class of 2004. During the COVID-19 pandemic, Wayland Baptist Theological Seminary recognized her with the Druecillar Fordham Award for Pastoral Excellence.

Dr. Mosby continued to lead and serve in impactful ways throughout her ministry. She served as a Trustee on the Board of Regents for Wayland Baptist Theological Seminary, worked with the Baptist World Alliance Commission on Racial, Gender, and Economic Justice, and mentored emerging women leaders through the RISE National Women's Mentoring Network.

In 2023, she joined the Advisory Board for the Katie Geneva Cannon Center for Womanist Leadership, and in 2025 was appointed to the Advisory Board for the Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology. She also made history as the first woman elected President of the African American Fellowship of Virginia, and currently serves on the Executive Board for the Baptist General Association of Virginia.

Her ministry has taken her around the world, including opportunities to serve in Paris, Ghana, and the Philippines, where she planted a church in 2015. Whether preaching internationally, teaching in the classroom, or leading workshops from her book, *When the War Comes Home with Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD): What Now*, Dr. Mosby remains committed to healing, hope, and wholeness — spiritually, mentally, and emotionally.

Above all, Dr. Mosby treasures faith, family, and community. She and her husband, Geoffrey A. Mosby, Sr., of Glen Allen, are proud parents, grandparents, and partners in ministry. Affectionately known as "Honey" to her ten grandchildren, she brings the same love, joy, and encouragement to her family that she shares with everyone blessed to know her.
